*	In addition to the above requirements, the district council delegates must be 14 years of age or older as of January 1st of the current year. If offices can not be filled by qualified
	members, offices shall be filled by nominations form the floor, consisting of council
	delegates.
*	Members must submit intent to run for office at the April meeting.
