Eligibility for Office - All Council officers shall meet the following requirements:

- ★ 3 years in active 4-H work as recorded in the County Extension Office.
- ★ Turn in a record book during the year preceding term office.
Attend no less than 7 of 10 regular council meetings during the last year in which he or she served as evidence by the council secretary's records.
- ★ In addition to the above requirements, the district council delegates must be 14 years of age or older as of January 1st of the current year. If offices can not be filled by qualified members, offices shall be filled by nominations from the floor, consisting of council delegates.
- ★ Members must submit intent to run for office at the April meeting.
