

# Multi-County Cotton & Grain Pre-Plant Conference

Agriculture Cotton & Grain Producers

The highlight of the conference is to increase knowledge on all areas of grain and cotton production. Producers had the opportunity to participate at the end of the conference on a required Texas Department of Agriculture, EPA regulation on the application of a state restricted chemical for cotton production.

#### Cameron Crop Hybrid Tests-Result Demonstration Research

Agriculture Result Research Test was established this spring at a local farm. The purpose is to evaluate hybrid variety performance at harvest and provide agriculture producers with the most current hybrid performance and adaptability to the Rio Grande Valley. Producers are provided with results/information that is current and research base as to hybrid varieties performance and are adapted to climatic and environmental conditions for planting in Cameron County. This information is useful in obtaining current hybrid varieties as crop producers evaluate their performance in different types of soils, type of irrigation systems, and method of plant spacing. The result will be available in August after all harvests are completed.

Our latest information in 2018 indicates a decline in capture rate in the Gulf of Mexico during the 3-year course of the Turtle Excluder Device Outreach Project.

> This is in direct correlation to our Gulf-wide efforts teaching TED compliance from Texas to Florida.





We initiated a new TED demonstration aboard Po Isabel bait shrimp vessel and installed a double cover TED. This vessel fishes primarily in the Brownsville Ship Channel for bait shrimp and the captain reports a significant reduction in large mud balls (a byproduct of dredging the ship channel) plugging up the net. He has reported an increase in his shrimp catch and an overall reduction in total bycatch. We will report more accurate data in our next quarterly after we have had time to analyze the effectiveness of the double cover TED.

### Shrimp Fishery

May 15, 2018



The Texas Shrimp Fishery closed out

200 nautical miles

to conserve shrimp migrating offshore &provide a greater catch

per unit effort when the season opens in July.

This winter approximately 40% of the Cameron County fleet was fishing off southwest Florida for pink shrimp. Catches exceeded those of our fleet fishing off Texas and Louisiana. We are concerned about this year's Texas shrimp crop because of the unusually cool spring and the freshet from Hurricane Harvey. Local bait shrimpers are saying the season, opening in July will be late.
