## **Section V. Officers**

The officers of Council shall be: President, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice - President, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice – President (recreation leader), 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice – President (charge of membership), Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, Parliamentarian, Historian, and Health & Safety Officer.

## **Eligibility for Office**

- Candidates for office of President for office of President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President must be 15 years old or older as of the current 4-H year.
- All other candidates must be 13 years old as September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current 4-H year.
- If all positions cannot be filled by qualified candidates, then nominations will be taken from the floor.
- 3 years in active 4-H work as recoded in the County Extension Office.
- Turn in a record book during the year preceding term office.
- Attend no less than 7 of 10 regular council meetings during the last year in which he or she served as evidence by the council secretary's records.
- Members must submit a letter of intent to run for office at the April meeting, or at an alternative date as set by the County Extension Agent or email to Marco Ponce at [Marco.Ponce@ag.tamu.edu](mailto:Marco.Ponce@ag.tamu.edu)
