I, (Name) _____ of Cameron County wish to run for the office of County 4-H Council (Position) _____ for the 2024 – 2025 4-H Year. By checking below, I certify that I meet the criteria in the county 4-H Council by-laws, and am eligible to run for said office. The by-laws are as follows:

Section V. Officers

The officers of Council shall be: President, 1st Vice - President, 2nd Vice – President (recreation leader), 3rd Vice – President (charge of membership), Secretary, Treasurer, Reporter, Parliamentarian, Historian, and Health & Safety Officer.

Eligibility for Office

- Candidates for office of President for office of President and 1st Vice President must be 15 years old or older as of the current 4-H year.
- All other candidates must be 13 years old as September 1st of the current 4-H year.
- If all positions cannot be filled by qualified candidates, then nominations will be taken from the floor.
- 3 years in active 4-H work as recorded in the County Extension Office.
- Turn in a record book during the year preceding term office.
- Attend no less than 7 of 10 regular council meetings during the last year in which he or she served as evidence by the council secretary's records.
- Members must submit a letter of intent to run for office at the April meeting, or at an alternative date as set by the County Extension Agent or email to Analisa Sanchez at Analisa.Sanchez@ag.tamu.edu
